Sensitive Data Continues to Exit Companies and Cost Millions

Global data breach costs climbed slightly last year



U.S. businesses paid an average cost of \$5.4 million per data breach

Mistakes still cause nearly 2/3 of data breaches

Malicious attacks
(including criminal insiders)

Worldwide, malicious attacks cost most at \$157 per stolen record, increasing to \$277 in the U.S.
